Copacabana Shawl

Copacabana Shawl

Worked from point to point in stripes with picot edge

Yarn: Circulo Duna-2 balls of MC (Crystal Rose) & CC (Almond), 1 ball of AC (Masala)

Needles: 5.00mm needles

Tension 17 sts x 35 rows for 10cm x 10cm

Size:

Shawl-Size 200cm wingspan and 35cm at deepest point

Abbreviations:

MC- main colour CC- contrast colour AC- accent colour sts-stitches RS- right side WS- wrong side K-knit KFB-knit into the front and back of the same stitch K2tog - knit 2 stitches together BO- bind off Cast On 2 stitches in MC Row 1(MC): KFB, K1 Row 2(MC): K1, KFB, K1

Join CC yarn **Row 3(CC):** KFB, K to last 2 sts, K2tog **Row 4(CC):** K to last 2 sts, KFB, K1 **Row 5(MC):** KFB, K to last 2 sts, K2tog **Row 6(MC):** K to last 2 sts, KFB, K1

Note: Yarn can be carried up the edge rather than cut at each colour change

Repeat these rows 3-6 until there are approx. 138 stripes/the scarf measures 145 cm along the shorter edge, 140 stitches

If you want a larger shawl, continue working rows 3-6 until desired size

Loosely cast off all stitches

Picot edge Using AC, pick up and knit all stitches along the 2 shortest edges.

Picot cast off Step 1: BO 2 stitches Step 2: Slip stitch on right needle back onto left needle Step 3: Cast on 2 stitches using knitted cast on Step 4: BO 4 stitches

Repeat steps 2-4 along all stitches.

Weave in ends and block your finished shawl
