

Geometria Necktie & Shawl

Worked from point to point to create a stunning gradient shawl

Yarn: 1 (2) Skeins Fiori Gradient Sock Hand Dyed 50g

Needles: 3.50mm needles

Tension: 38 st x 44 rows for 10cm x 10cm



Size:

Necktie (Shawl)-105cm (150) finished length

Abbreviations:

K-knit

KFB-knit into the front and back of the same stitch

K2tog - knit 2 stitches together



Set up: Cast on 3 stitches

Row 1: K3, slip stitches back onto left needle Repeat 4 more times to create an icord

Pick up and knit 3 stitches down the side of your icord. These stitches will become the garter stitch section of the shawl
Pick up (but don't knit) 3 stitches along the cast on edge. These stitches will become the icord edge.

Pattern repeat for increasing side of shawl:

Row 1: K to last 3 stitches, slip 3

Row 2-5: Repeat row 1

Row 6: K to last 4 stitches, KFB, slip 3

Repeat this pattern until approx. 26g (2g) yarn remain from your first skein, ending on row 6

Pattern repeat for decreasing side of shawl:

Row 1: K to last 3 stitches, slip 3

Row 2-5: Repeat row 1

Row 6: K to last 5 stitches, K2tog, slip 3

Repeat decreasing pattern until 9 stitches remain.

Finishing your shawl:

Row 1: K to last 3 stitches, slip 3

Row 2: k3, cast off 3, slip 3

Row 3: k3, slip these 3 stitches back onto

left needle

Repeat row 3 for 3 more times

Using kithener stitch graft the first 3 stitches and the last 3 stitches together.

Using the tail, sew the 3 cast off stitches onto the iord loop you have jut created. Weave in ends and block to desired size. Note: you can aggressively block to get a much larger shawl if desired
